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Has/Have

This deck of *Pair-Ups: Has/Have* targets the use of *has/have*. There are 26 pairs of *has/have* cards. Each pair consists of a *has* card and a matching *have* card, such as *She has a cat/They have a cat*.

At first, present up to six pairs of *has/have* cards at a time and make sure your students can label them and match them appropriately. As your students identify correct matches, model complete sentences that use *has/have* correctly. Then use the cards to play games requiring matching pairs of cards, such as *Go Fish* and *Memory*.

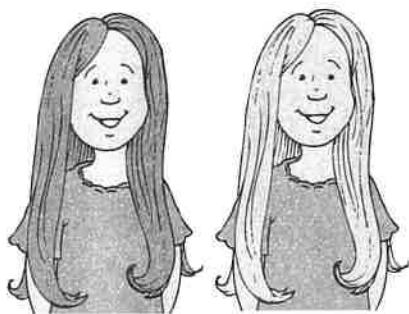
Use your own judgment about the complexity of the responses to require from your students, depending on their expressive language skills.
