This deck of Pair-Ups: Opposites 2 targets slightly more complex antonyms than those found in Pair-Ups: Opposites 1. Each of the 26 pairs of opposite cards consists of two pictures of opposite concepts, such as even and uneven.


At first, present up to six pairs of opposite cards at a time and make sure your students can label them and match them appropriately. As your students identify correct matches, model complete sentences that explain the relationship between the two cards, such as *Even* is the opposite of uneven or These bangs are even, but these bangs are uneven. Ask your students to name other things that show the same characteristics, such as lines that can be even or uneven. Then use these cards to play games requiring matching pairs of cards, such as Go Fish and Memory.

Use your own judgment about the complexity of the responses to require from your students, depending on their expressive language skills.

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
