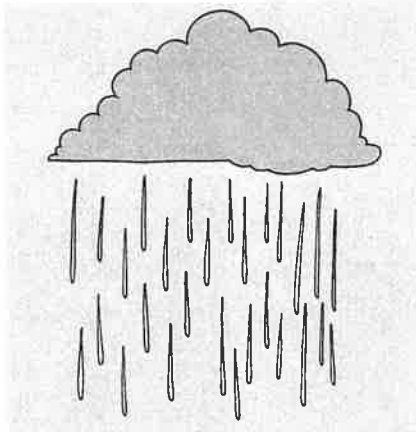
## What

This deck of *Pair-Ups: What?* targets asking and answering *what* questions. There are 26 pairs of *what* cards. Each pair consists of a *what* question card and a matching answer card, such as *What keeps you dry in the rain?* (*An umbrella*).

At first, present up to six pairs of *what* question and answer cards at a time and make sure your students can label them and match them appropriately. As your students identify correct matches, model the *what* questions on the cards. Then use the cards to play games requiring matching pairs of cards, such as *Go Fish* and *Memory*.

Use your own judgment about the complexity of the responses to require from your students, depending on their expressive language skills.
